

PC Carbine™ Drop-In Mag Release Installation Instructions

For Glock Magwell

- 1. Ensure that the rifle is unloaded.
- 2. Loosen magazine release button screw carefully so that spring doesn't fly out.
- 3. Set the spring, button, and screw aside.
- 4. Push the original magazine release through and pull it out the other side.
- 5. Insert Jawbone Drop-In Mag Release.
- 6. Insert magazine release spring onto threaded rod. You can use the original Ruger® Spring but we recommend using our stiffer spring (included with our mag release).
- 7. Carefully put the button and screw over spring and thread screw into threaded rod, ensuring that the button is lined up with the hole in the receiver.
- 8. Test for normal function.
- 9. Insert an empty magazine and make sure it locks in place and drops free when the lever is depressed.
- 10. Throw it in the truck and get your ass to the range.



For Ruger® Magwell

- 1. Ensure that the rifle is unloaded.
- 2. Loosen magazine release button screw carefully so that spring doesn't fly out.
- 3. Set the spring, button, and screw aside.
- 4. Using your finger inside the magwell, compress the magazine latch (See Picture).



- 5. Push the original magazine release through and pull it out the other side.
- 6. While still compressing the magazine latch inside the magwell, insert Jawbone Drop-In Mag Release.
- 7. Insert magazine release spring onto threaded rod. You can use the original Ruger® Spring but we recommend using our stiffer spring (included with our mag release).
- 8. Carefully put the button and screw over spring and thread screw into threaded rod, ensuring that the button is lined up with the hole in the receiver.
- 9. Test for normal function.
- 10. Insert an empty magazine and make sure it locks in place and drops free when the lever is depressed.
- 11. Throw it in the truck and get your ass to the range.
