

P365 AXG/AXG Legion CCW Magwell Installation Instructions

If you can't figure this out, then you need to take it to a gunsmith. There is no shame in that, some people are mechanically inclined, some are not. If you destroy your grip module, damage the magwell, or cross-thread the screw, tough luck. You should have taken it to a gunsmith. Jawbone assumes no responsibility for damage done to anything due to negligence or inability to put a screw in a hole. If you have any questions about it, feel free to call or contact us through our website.

***The grip module you bought probably came with a magwell already installed, if you managed to remove that, then this should be a piece of cake. It installs/uninstalls the exact same way.

If you are confident in your ability to handle this installation (then you really shouldn't need instructions, but here they are anyway):

- 1. Make sure your gun is unloaded.
- 2. Make sure it is compatible with this magwell. If you're not sure, you probably didn't read the description when you ordered it.
- 3. Hook the lip on the front of the magwell into the slot at the front of the grip. Then lever it back till it fits flush.
- 4. Once it fits flush on the bottom of the grip, install the provided M3 screw (feel free to use some blue Loctite if you want). This is a small screw with fine threads, don't go crazy. 8-10 in-lbs is plenty of torque.
- 5. Verify that it's fitting flush, and that your magazines still fit in the gun.
- 6. Go shoot.
